REPAIRS, &c.

Caulked Butts and seams of topsides or from the metal line upwards, including waterway and main deck.

Doubled the main Deck between the Poop and forecasse with Pine 2 ins thick on felt. - Fitted a deep Cant piece below at the Poop, and one above, also iron knees to breast beams. - Forecasse deck, rough tree tails, gunwale to forecasse deck and caulking of the same all made good. New Casheads. Iron Hook to stanchions above the forecasse fixed bolted and secured.
