Repaired the yellow metal sheathing.
 Lipped the timbers each side the middle line all fore and aft on both sides, also a strake of the close ceiling, at the lower part of bilges both sides throughout, and some lining or filling pieces from the ribs at the upper turn of bilges. Scraped clean the ribs, and the inner planking from the ribs.
 — Examined the iron frames. could not discover any galvanic action. — Found the cement in the flat of bottom adhering satisfactorily and all parts in good condition.
