## REPAIRS, &c.

Sighted the Bottom, patched the yellow metal sheathing. Caulked four upper seams of topsides. Six Iron bolts on each side in stowage just above metal line driven out for examination found good the limber boards, and ceiling equal to two stowages removed all fore and aft, cement, iron work, and bolts examined and found in good condition. Doubled the heel of fore & main masts with 58 plates about four feet long
