Caulking of Bottom, Deck, and Waterways <u>good</u>		

Sighted the yellow metal sheathing and repaired it. Lifted the Chain Cables from the lockers, ranged them along the deck and found them sufficient in size and in quantity also. unhinged the Windlass. Stripped it of the linings (the main piece is sound) refitted it and put all in order as before, and preparatory or in anticipation of the Harbore Survey Rule being completed on her return from her voyage.
