REPAIRS, &c.

The hold, timbers and all air courses, cleared, and listings cut in accordance with Rule Section 37. All the yellow metal sheathing stripped off; outside planking scraped bright in places; bolts and trenails driven out for survey found good; windlass stripped and unhung, and chains ranged on deck for examination, found good and complete; Renewed the fore and after lengths of false keel with American Elm, and nineteen side bolts found broken with yellow metal; The vessel hung in shores, caulked from keel to third seam inside the waterways, and resheathed with yellow metal on felt.
