REPAIRS, &c.

Stripped off all the yellow metal sheathing. Caulked from keel to gunwale, sheathed with yellow metal on felt renewed clean short lengths of Top deck planking with G. Pine and several chain and preventer bolts with galvanized iron. The Owners apply for an increase of class under the mixed material Rule. I find from first Entry Report that a large quantity of Teak is used in her construction. the workmanship is of the best description. She has now been salted at the ends.
