## REPAIRS, &c.

The hold, timbers, and all air courses cleared; outside planking scraped bright in places. Bolts and treenails driven out for survey found good. Windlass stripped and unhung, and chains ranged on deck for examination. Caulked from keel to gunwale, and the deck under. Windlass, re-shathed with yellow metal on felt. Renewed all the comings with Baltic Oak, and fitted new Port Towsenpipe. Now supplied with 30 fathoms of 1 1/2" chain cable 15 1/3 fathoms 1 1/2" chain tested to 40 1/2 tons.
