REPAIRS, &c.

The hold, timbers, and all air courses cleared, and listings cut in accordance with Rule Section 37. Outside planking scraped bright in places, bolts and treenails driven out for survey found good, windlass stripped and unhung and cables ranged on deck for examination found good and sufficient. Stripped off all the yellow metal sheathing, hung the vessel in shoves, caulked from keel to waterway seams, and resheathed the bottom with yellow metal on felt.
