Now done, the yellow metal sheathing stripped off, the whole of the Galvanized Iron fastenings remaining (part done last voyage) renewed with bellow metal from 1/5th the depth of hold down as per rule for metal fastening. the Cement entirely renewed, the vessel recaulked from keel to planksheers and resheathed with yellow metal on felt. The Chains ranged for 1/2 time and found correct.
