REPAIRS, &c.

Now done in anticipation of the requirements of the Rules for Half Time Survey. The hold, timbers and all air courses and listings cleared. Chain cables ranged on deck examined and found complete caulked from keel to upper edge of doubling and blacked the bottom. On the vessels return the windlass will be stripped and turnails driven out to complete the Half Time Survey.
