The hold cleared, Limbers lifted and ceiling equal to two strakes removed, and the cement and frame found in good condition, the windlass unhung and stripped and cables ranged - In consequence of damage, the mizen mast and all attached renewed;

When the strake of close ceiling, <sup>in live decks.</sup> required by the Rule is removed next year the vessel will then complete No 2 Survey.
