In consequence of damage, see Special Report. Yellow metal stripped off resulted from keel to metal line, hung in shores, about 70 ft of false keel renewed and the yellow metal sheathing renewed on felt — Half Time

The whole of the ceiling from bilges down removed and floors found all good. The windlass un-hung and stripped, and the chains ranged — According to this vessel's materials I am of opinion ~~she~~ has no claim to an improved class.
