Yellow metal sheathing stripped off & scraped bright
from waterway seam to light water mark, all treenails renewed
from planks near to bulges, a plank removed on each bow and
buttock (frame very good) new listings cut out in the hold (frame
all good) the strakes of deck next the waterway taken out, remaining
beams bored and all found good, the windlass renewed and cables
ranged and found sufficient.

The planks removed for survey renewed with E. S. Teak, retreenailed to bilges with stungy bark, recaulked throughout and resheathed with yellow metal on felt.
