The yellow metal sheathing stripped off. Six teen timbers renewed in port Bow, above water line. Eight straps of outside planking from stem to turn of Bow. Four lengths of ceiling, and the upper deck clamps scarfed; all of Pear. One Bow breasthook rebolted, and two hanging knees refitted and bolted.  
Baulked from keel upwards over all, and resheathed with yellow metal on felt.
