REPAIRS, &c.

Stripped off the whole of the Yellow Metal Sheathing drifted out a couple of Yellow Metal bolts below the Metal line and three galvaniz'd bolts above, lifted the timbers, the Ceiling Hatches, and more than a stroke of Ceiling from each side fore and aft, examin'd the Cement found it in good condition over the iron ribs, and adhering satisfactorily. — Overhauled Ribs floor plates, and the planking inside and outside. —

Caulk'd from Keel up to Metal line, Resheath'd with Yellow Metal. — Made a Barque of her, and put the rigging all in order.
