One iron hanging knee to hold beams; and one iron breasthook that were found cracked in their throats, have been taken down repaired, refitted, and thro' fastened with Yellow Metal bolts. added one iron breasthook in the lower hold, the same thro' fastened with Yellow Metal bolts; patched Yellow Metal Sheathing.
