REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Metalling & Raise of Class Expired

The yellow metal sheathing removed, and the bottom sighted. Topsides, Wales, Waterways, and inside Ceiling scraped bright. A 3 inch listing cut out tween-decks to ascertain the condition of the timbers. all parts found in good condition. Vessel caulked from keel to gunwale, and the bottom resheathed with yellow metal on felt.
