This is a new vessel docked for the purpose of metalling only, after being metalled and having taken in some cargo, she was found to be making water, she was then docked again, & tested with water inside, when several butts at turn of bilge & garboards forward were found rent, these have now been effectually secured and made tight. The vessel is in a good & efficient condition and eligible in our opinion to remain as classed
