Having been on shore in China the following repairs have been done in consequence. Viz—

Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off, vessel caulked to waterways and on deck where necessary in damage to deck houses, bulwarks &c. repaired in two new boats supplied in iron frames & plates cleaned & repainted in the 'tween decks and re-metalled on paper to same height as before in caulking tested.
