PAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Special Survey

The Vessel placed in dry dock on blocks, and the bottom and keel sighted, the yellow metal patched. Rudder unskipped and main piece renewed with Teak, Limbers and Ceiling equal to two strakes on each side lifted all fore and aft, the cement where exposed in good condition and firmly adhering to the frame and outside planking, the openings where exposed cleaned and washed with Cement.
