On account of defects: The Stem renewed from Head downwards about 19 feet. Runged Heads and House timbers new on both sides. Three fore hoods of sides each side renewed. timbers there found good. The new material all of Teak. One House pipe new. Runged lifted and all made good there. Pins of dead-eyes renewed.
