Shain 30 4/10 tons Lloyd's P. H. Tipton 30th March 1876 Saml. Hegema one Bower Anchor. weight 8" 2" 9" P. Shain 10-14-0-0 No 3577 Lloyd's P. H. Chester 23rd March Andrew S Jack.
