REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE. Damage Repairs &c.  
Yellow metal sheathing removed, the bottom and keel examined, recaulked from keel to gunwale and the bottom sheathed with yellow metal over felts.

Damage Repairs- Main piece of Rudder renewed with English Oak main yard and main topsail yard new of Pitch Pine, Bulwarks on each side renewed with Pine board, Foresail & main lower topsail new, added an Iron shifting beam to main hatch to support Fore & After.
