REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE
 Yellow Metal stripped off Bottom cleaned down. Caulked from keel to upper part of Wales and Re-metalled over felt to the same height. Lanyards and Pins of deadeyes generally renewed. It is intended on the return of this ship to submit her for the special survey now nearly due. The said survey has on the present occasion been complied with so far as relates to the examination of Bottom and testing the condition of the lead bolts in upper works, not less than 6 having been removed on each side and found good.
