REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Cause of Repairs to be clearly stated

This ship has been surveyed in consequence of her having proved leaky on her last homeward voyage. The cause of leakage was discovered to have arisen from an open bolt hole in the bottom. Yellow metal now stripped off. Bottom cleaned down. Caulked from keel to pinnacle and retanned over felt as before. Surveyed with part Cargo in Hold.
