REPAIRS, &c.

Stripped off all the yellow metal sheathing. Caulked from keel to gunwale, sheathed with yellow metal on felt to 1st Water line - two short lengths of false keel renewed with Birch. the two lower rudder braces rebolted with yellow metal - fitted new main Mast, and Mizzen-top Mast of P. Pine, and renewed all the lower rigging with galvanized wire.


