REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE for Half Line  
Yellow metal stripped off and bottom cleaned down. Distangs opened inside at the ends. Bolts and treenails driven out as per Rule. Windlass unhooked & slivings renewed. Chain cables laid out on deck and all other requirements complied with.  
One pair of Hanging Knees now fitted to the fore Hold Beam and several Hook bolts renewed. Main Hatchway Comings part renewed. Caulked from keel to gunwale and Rebutted over-felt as before.
