At the present time placed on the

and outside, the timbers and air courses cleared, outside
planking scraped bright in a few places, 12 Treennails driven out
on both sides at various places. (C.F.) Knee and Binding Bolts
tested. Windlass new last October at the Manufactory of ^{Manufactory} ~~Native~~ ^{Hard Wood}
Now lining partly stripped off.
Chain cables ranged on deck for examination 210 fathoms
Caulking tested & found good.
1 length of Riding Nelson Pitch Pine, bedding repaired.
