REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Repairs.

This vessel has been placed in dry dock & metal sheathing patched. The whole of the battens & above ^{closed} fixed ceiling in hold have been removed, frames clipped & cleaned & frames cemented higher. Two frames for ² on port side repaired and a panting beam added attached to ^{short} angle iron stringer, now fitted, with gusset-plates.

Chains were ranged on deck, found 270 fathoms in good condition. Examined with Ballast in hold.

In this case the Owner's attention has been called to the class of this vessel expiring in Sep^r of the present year.
