REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Placed on blocks in Dry Dock for examination of Keel and Bottom. 2 Gaving pieces let into fore hood planks at light line on Port side on account of slight warping. The Yellow Lead sheathing repaired and painted, about two hundred sheets renewed; Rudder lifted, Braces, and pintles examined & bushed. Windlass purchase repaired. 2 New Topgallant Masts fitted on acct of Damage.
3 Topgallant Stanchions, on Port side, & G Forecastle, renewed with oak. Plank Sheer repaired about 22 feet. I. G Rail fitted & Chrome renewed. Bathead Hook & Blister repaired, and a length of I. G. Rail on Poop renewed with K. Elm.
