REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

This vessel has now been placed in dry dock and a preliminary examination has been made with a view to her being classed in Red. The attention of the Owner's representative was called to the defective condition of the ceiling for some distance below the hold beam clamps, and he was informed that it would be necessary to renew a great part of the same in order to reclass the vessel.

The Owners have decided not to continue the survey and have put the vessel out of dry dock.

Ballast was lying over the hold of this vessel up to the level of upper turn of bilge.
