After damage by collision! — The stem entirely renewed. The fore lengths of plating in each of the 9 strakes from fore-castle rail down, together with two following lengths (in the 5th and 8th strakes) and three doubling plates in the 6th, 7th and 8th strakes renewed on S^c side: and a similar number of plates renewed in the port side, together with an additional plate in the sheer-strake, and two plates (in the 10th and 11th strakes) from fore-castle rail. Two frames new on each side and both Heerwal pipes renewed, with other smaller repairs.
