Particulars of Repairs and Examination Special Survey and Damage

Examined Sea cocks & Connections. Corrosion had commenced near one of the blow off cocks, recommended a brass washer to be fitted on outside of plating which has been done.

Examined tunnel stuffing crankshaft cylinders, ^{slides} and pumps which were in good condition except Thrust block & shaft; the collars on shaft have been turned true & new brass ring fitted to Thrust block.

The propeller & tunnel stuffing have been refitted.

The tubes in the boilers have been removed & new one fitted in their place. The boilers appear to be in a good condition. The safety valves (weighted) are in good working order.

Found ballast donkey discharge pipe cracked. A new one has been fitted.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the machinery of this vessel appears in safe working condition and eligible in my opinion to have the notification Lloyds M.C. 9.81 recorded in the Register Books.
