Cause of Repairs to be clearly stated.

At the present time the vessel placed in the dry dock the close ceiling in the lower hold taken up on both sides exposing surfaces of plating examined and found good & the cement adhering firmly to the iron. Oxidation stripped and beaten off inside and outside. The Mizzen Royal stay, Main topmast, Main Royal yard and Mizzen topgallant yard new. The Fore sail & spanker also new. The outside plating is in such good condition that it was not deemed necessary to drill holes in it.
