This vessel went on the Pontoon to coast the bottom & annual survey, on examination the Intercoastal keelson in the after hold in some of the spaces between the floors were wasted away, also some of the floors the same. The floors have been doubled butting in the middle line but no butt straps on the them. The sheerstake in the Starboard coal bunker was wasted through and a piece has been put into it about 3 ft long & about 2 ft deep, being about 1 no stage, could not be exactly taken. The reversed bars on the frames where they could be seen in the coal bunkers are wasted. For further particulars see letter attached
