Examined boilers, found them in good condition, the tubes have been renewed.

Examined the Safety valves, slide valves and chambers, cylinders and pumps & found them in a good condition.

The tail and thrust shaft were found to be in a good condition.

The safety valves of the main and donkey boilers have been tested by Mr. Hirst as per enclosure.
