Through packing of a shaking by screw propeller & other causes
 some rivets loosened in after frames and some screw mud
 bolts through ones; introduced between frames in starboard
 and shake above right aft. Rudder partly riveted.
 Starboard plate repaired with an angled doubling plate
 Bottom repainted.
