(State cause of Repairs.)
Vessel placed in dry dock sea connections examined & found to be in good condition. Propeller & its connections found to be sound & the tail shaft down $\frac{3}{16}$ " in Stern Bush.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The sea connections & propeller being in good condition & the rest of the machinery having been seen in June, renders the vessel eligible in my opinion to have the certification L.M.C. G. 82 recorded.
