(State cause of Repairs.)

Examined Leacocks & connections & found them in good condition.

Examined Cylinders & Slide valves, pumps & crankshaft & found them in good condition.

Examined main boiler & found it in good condition

Examined donkey boiler & found the dimensions to be in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 60 lb. Allowed weights equal to 50 lb. per square inch to be placed on the valve.

The donkey boiler safety valve blows off at 48 lbs per square inch.

Set safety valves of main boiler to 70 lb. per square inch.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe working condition and the vessel is in my opinion eligible to have the notification L M. C. 5.82 recorded in the Register Book


