Found the yellow metal on the port side abraded but not cut and the yellow metal sheathing free from wrinkling. Tested the caulking on removal of some of the bruised metal and also further aft and found it satisfactory. On examination of inside also found her free from damage.
This vessel is in good and efficient condition & eligible in our opinion to remain as classed.
