REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Cause of Repairs to be clearly stated.

At present the wood ceiling taken off the top of double Bottom and the plates scraped and coated with boiled wood tar (Stockholm) and cement. Several butts on both sides of flat of bottom caulked. Some of the slanting Pillars in the hold have been put perpendicular so as Wood cargoes can be well stowed. Bottom & coated. Ceiling relaid on double Bottom.
