General Observations, Opinion as to Class, &c. The bottom has been examined and coated. The rudder stock partly renewed. Vessel surveyed with part outward cargo in hold. This vessel has had a freeboard assigned to her of 4' 8" for salt water and 4' 3 1/2" for fresh water (see Committee's Minute dated 16th Nov 1882). The Owner states that the above freeboard was marked on the vessel's sides, but as the vessel started on her voyage on the 16th November the same date as Committee's Minute no opportunity occurred to examine the freeboard on the vessel. She appears in good condition & eligible to remain as Classed.


