Examined seacocks & connections & found them in a good condition. The lignum vitae in stern tube has been renewed.

A new donkey boiler has been fitted by Mr R White of Millwall. No opportunity was afforded me of examining or testing it. The owners representative said it would be submitted for inspection on the Tyne where the vessel is now trading. The Newcastle Surveyors have been informed of the case & and the particulars (as far as <sup>they</sup> could be ascertained) have been forwarded to them.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe working condition and provided the report on the donkey boiler is satisfactory the vessel appears in my opinion to be eligible to remain as classed.
