

The Government having taken her Transport Service requires of the owners to put another Water-tight Bulkhead fitted at the Foremast. The plates are 1/16 & the vertical angles Irons 3 1/2 x 3 1/2 x 3/16 & spaced 3/4 to 5/8 feet apart, & is secured to a single frame. A copy of my letter to the owner & the owners reply were attached. The Government Surveyors are quite satisfied with it, & recommended it to be done as it is.
