This vessel has now been placed in Dry Dock the bottom examined and recoated with paint, Topgallant rail from Mizzen Mast aft on both sides, and one length between fore rigging & fore-castle on port side, removed with leak, the iron Stanchions & Guard rails abaft Mizzen rigging repaired and refitted, the Main deck recoated from break forward - Cement in bottom repaired where found necessary and the house on deck strengthened with diagonal trusses at each end and in the middle.
