Examined Seacocks & connections & found them good.
The tailshaft has been drawn & found good and new
brass vices fitted. The crankshaft was found good.
Examined Pumps & condenser & found them full
of sand but in a good condition.
Examined the two main boilers & found them in a
good condition. A few small repairs have been done
to them.
The Cylinders & slide valves have not been seen.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— As far as seen the
machinery of this vessel appears to be in a safe
working condition and it is submitted that this
vessel is eligible to have the notification B & M.S.
2.84 recorded in the Register Book.
