PAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Damage Repairs.

At present the vessel placed in the Dry Dock one new Rudder brace fitted strained and slack rivets renewed in the Rudder. Part angle iron collar replaced on the Rudder Trunk, cement renewed at the bottom of Rudder Trunk, inside of Stern Post & at gunwale at the inside of Stern on Deck. Pieces fitted on Rudder stops, Butt Plate fitted on arch piece between the Stern Posts. Bent iron bars of Steering gear set fair. Supplied 1 Bower Anchor 27-3-14 Tested to 27-0-2-14 River Near Machine 18th May 1883, signed J Hartnup, Bottom Painted,
