At the present time the vessel placed in the dry dock the bottom scraped & coated, timbers and ceiling equal to 3 & more strakes lifted examined and found good and the cement adhering firmly to the iron and thickened where worn.

Chain cables ranged for examination, Windlass good, renewed last survey.
