It was stated that the defective crankshaft had been removed and replaced by a new one. This crankshaft was not opened out on account of the shortness of time. The defective old crankshaft was fitted with a pin through the crank pin. See Report No 42112. The present crank has no pin fitted to either crank pin. It is submitted that the absence of the pin in question be considered as evidence of the removal of the crankshaft.

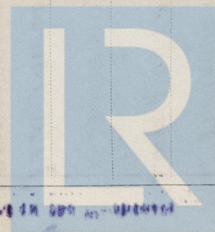
