The four main steam cylinders have been renewed. The cracked cast iron piston pipes have been replaced by brass ones. All the brass bearings have been renewed. The condenser tubes have been drawn cleaned & replaced. The pumps have been overhauled.

The engines have been tried under steam and were found to work satisfactory.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible to remain as classed without the limit on cylinders.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:— The machinery of this vessel appears now to be in a safe working condition and is in my opinion eligible to be removed from the list of limited machinery certificates and to remain as classed in the Register Book.
